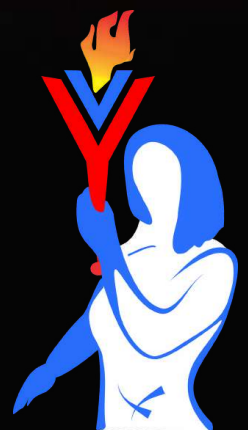

About Us

Our NGO, **Youth Veerangnayan** is a group of young (18-40 yrs.) women who crusade against social evils by organizing seminars, de-addiction camps, etc. Our volunteers work diligently towards their aim to empower women with knowledge and skill, so that they can be financially independent and have a voice in decision-making in their family and society in general. We achieve this by providing knowledge, education, vocational training, skill development, counseling, and appliances to the deprived, to enable them to live a dignified life.

We run skill development centers in semi-urban areas to provide vocational training for underprivileged women. We also make people, women in particular aware about leading a healthy lifestyle through our communication and demonstrations at the grassroots.

The volunteers of Youth Veerangnayan comprises a group of talented and experienced doctors, engineers, principals, teachers, and intellectuals, who are experts in their respective fields. We are supported by dedicated staff who bring their enthusiasm to our programs and initiatives. We provide vocational skills to deprived women to enable them to stand on their own feet. These women are trained at our stitching centers, computer centers, and centers for training in beauty and make-up.

Our programs have been designed as innovative solutions to drive true change. To bring the maximum benefit, we work with cooperation of local people and government officials. We take tiny steps but we move with strong determination and take calculated risks to benefit maximum number of girls and women.





OUR INITIATIVES



Distribution Campaigns

Mother Teresa said, **"If you can't feed a hundred people, then feed just one"**. These words continue to be a huge source of inspiration as we continue to organize distribution campaigns across several states in India.

Millions of Indians struggle everyday for two square meals. With our distribution campaigns, we solve the problems of thousands of them. Our distribution campaigns begin at the grassroots, where our volunteers identify families in need. Our next step is to ascertain their requirements and procure the rations. Once that is complete, we distribute.

Often, we also distribute clothes for those who can't afford them. In the last year, a little over 4000 people were provided food items free of cost in Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Delhi and Madhya Pradesh. Also, over 900 people were provided with weather-appropriate clothes in these states.



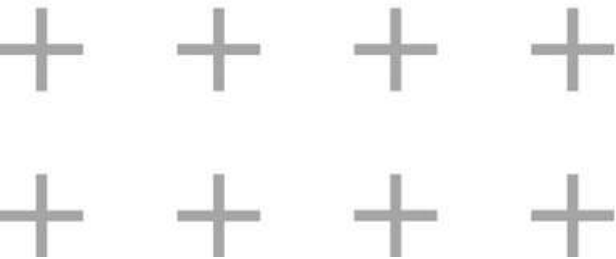


Women Empowerment



In sync with our mission to equip girls and women with skills and knowledge to become financially independent, we run several training centers to train women and young girls in stitching, beauty and make-up. In addition, we also conduct seminars on issues that affect women like female feticide, domestic violence, menstrual hygiene, etc. We often invite subject experts during our seminar so that they can adequately address these issues. Overall, our objective is to enhance the financial and social status of poor women by enabling them to become self-dependent.





Seminars



Youth Veerangnayen has vowed to bring a positive change in society. We are determined in our aim of creating awareness in society through our steady efforts. In 2019, our team held seminars in schools, colleges, parks, coaching centers and several public places. This year, our seminars focused on a variety of themes, including the role of youth in nation building, the benefits of blood donation and social evils that are hindering the development of our nation.

RALLIES



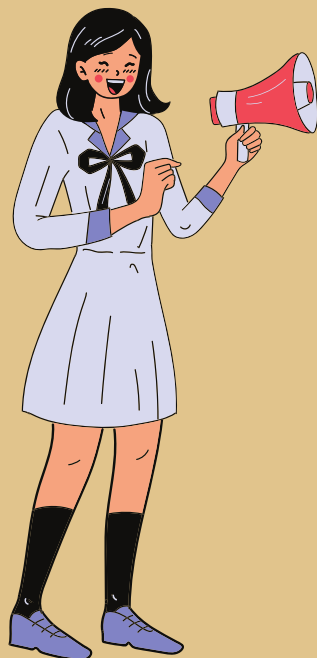
In the last few years, our awareness rallies have gained wide recognition and profoundly impacted hundreds of lives. This year was no different.

Carrying forward our tradition, **Youth Veerangnayan** organized a total of 38 rallies across Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Delhi in 2019-20. And we were successful in creating awareness about social evils like female feticide, tobacco usage, and child labor practices that continue to plague our society.



AWARENESS

Awareness among people plays a crucial role in social development. We at Youth Veerangnayan are contributing in this direction by organizing different events. Our volunteers believe that it is their duty to make aware the common folk their duties towards the society. To fulfill this duty, we painted slogans in different localities, organized street plays (*nukkad natak*), group discussions and competitions to ignite a thought about social evils in the minds of women, children and our onlookers alike.

ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES



With increased digitalization and industrialization, our way of living has become less sustainable and given rise to issues such as climate change. There is an immediate need to work on essential measures that promote a healthy environment.

The volunteers of Youth Veerangnayan have been actively working in this direction and carrying out activities in schools and different localities to spread awareness in school children and the general public in this regard.



FEEDING BIRDS



At Youth Veerangnayen, we strongly believe that nature is a place to co-exist. We have often organized events to install bird-feeders in parks and vicinities.



ANTI CHILD LABOUR DAY



There is an urgent need to end child labour. We see many children around us toiling in hotels, dhabas, homes, cigarette and cracker factories, and farms. Working robs these children off their right to education and the opportunity to grow in a healthy and wholesome atmosphere. After all, a happy childhood is the first step towards a bright future. But, a happy future distant dream for many children in India.

Youth Veerangnayan volunteers have conducted over 300 seminars in Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Delhi and Madhya Pradesh to raise awareness about this issue and strived to make India a place free of the social evil of child labour.



Stationery distribution & Free study centers



Millions of children do not have access to education due to their financial status. Often, unprivileged children face discrimination in learning environments or have lifestyles not conducive for learning. Many of these children leave school before they can acquire the basic skills and knowledge needed to thrive within society. We believe education is the route out of poverty for most of these children. It can give them to improve and transform their lives. Many students living in backward areas or urban slums also do not have access to stationery items like pen, pencils, copy, books etc. as they cannot afford them. Youth Veerangnayen opened over 35 free study centers to impart basic literacy skills and also distributed stationery among the poor children living in rural and backward areas



COMPETITIONS



Youth Veerangnayan organizes various competitions in schools, colleges, parks and community centers on days observed by the UN. These competitions are organized with the aim of allowing the young minds to express their creative selves while also igniting discussions on important issues.



We at Youth Veerangnayan believe that our youth has the ability to become a transformed generation, away from age-old mindsets that have given rise to patriarchy and other issues. And to achieve this, it is necessary to give a right direction to the young minds. Youth Veerangnayan volunteers continually put efforts in this direction.



YOGA FOR HEALTH



"It is the health that is the real **wealth**". Yoga is an invaluable part of India's ancient tradition and is a holistic approach to health and well-being. International Yoga Day is celebrated on 21st of June every year. On this day, Youth Veerangnayen organized several Yoga camps for girls and women. These camps included teaching various yoga poses called "**Asanas**" like *Padmasana*, *Chakrasana* etc. as well as some basic exercises that women can include in their daily routines to build their immunity and stay healthy.

Youth Veerangnayen also organizes free Yoga sessions for all age groups from time to time. We believe practicing Yoga everyday makes a person physically and mentally strong. Yoga has been adopted by many people as a part of lifestyle rather than a form of exercise and we communicate that through our efforts.
