What is the most disconcerting is the fact that across the globe, women exercising or even seeking their basic rights are being interpreted as challenges to existing social structures. Every morning, the newspapers come bearing sad news. The endless cases of domestic violence, sexual assaults, honor killing, girl child abuse, and female infanticide are alarming. But I see a ray of hope. The government has woken up; strict laws are being framed against sexual crimes. Celebrities are being chastised for their irresponsible comments about rape. Women-centric movies have garnered attention on social media platforms and other awareness programs, initiated by individuals and welfare societies, are beginning to reach the masses. Society has begun to frown upon those shaming the rape victim.

The government has also initiated programs like "BetiBachoBetiPadhao", which is commendable. A discussion about the rights of women has started in society, and I hear it, in parts, when I travel or visit markets or restaurants. Today, I envision a future where girls are free to go to school, where the birth of a girl is celebrated, where women have full control over their bodies, where women have equal rights, and where a girl can walk freely in the streets without the fear, where young boys are taught at home to respect every other human being including women, where no one forces anyone for dowry and where women can contribute to society and achieve their maximum potential. Youth Veerangnayen has adopted a multi-pronged strategy to empower women and work towards building such a future.

Drug addiction has become a major problem in the northern parts of the country. Although addiction is more common in men, due to its financial, social, and health-related ramifications, the women in the family suffer the most. Hence, Youth Veerangnayen is helping addicts and their families by providing and directing them to avenues for deaddiction. It has been a wonderful year for Youth Veerangnayen and is a relatively good year for women in general.

We run skill development centers in semi-urban areas providing free vocational training for the underprivileged. The Youth Veerangnayen is a group of Young (18-40 yrs.) women who crusade against social evils by organizing rallies, seminars, de-addiction camps, etc while aiding women and children. The Volunteers of Youth Veerangnayen mainly comprise a group of talented and experienced doctors, engineers, principals, teachers, and intellectuals, who are experts in their respective fields and are supported by enthusiastic staff who are a breath of freshness in the whole program. With the co-operation of locals and government support functions, we have designed a plan and commit to innovative solutions that drive true change. We take tiny steps but we move with strong determination and take a responsible risk to benefit the maximum number of girls and women.
