

Since we are an organization run by women, for women, our work with other sections has come out as a byproduct of our extensive work with women. EMPOWERMENT

For over a decade, we have taught vocational skills to women from disadvantaged backgrounds for free. Over the last year, we continued this work in this direction and added expert interactions and felicitation ceremonies to further support women joining us.

AWARENESS & HEALTH

To improve understanding of menstrual hygiene in rural areas, we continued our free sanitary pad distribution drives and strengthened our efforts to break down taboos around menstruation.

Furthermore, we adopted pregnant women and breastfeeding mothers in need and provided them with supplements and medicines wherever needed.




ENVIRONMENT


